We are excited to welcome students back to school on August 26 to kick off the 2020-2021 school year. As we begin our year utilizing a remote learning platform, we aim to provide a thoughtful and rigorous curriculum to all students. Listed below is the St. Joseph Catholic School Remote Learning Plan/ Expectations. Please become familiar with this plan and commit to working as a team with your children and school faculty to make this school year the best that it can be. Thank you for your dedication.

Instructional Delivery Platform

Google Classroom and other apps in the Google Suite, such as Google Docs. & Gmail, will be utilized across grade levels. Remind & Bloomz will also be used as a form of parent/ teacher communication. Instruction will be delivered using a blend of instructional videos, required live meets, and small group meets. Specialist time, independent work time, breaks, lunch, and recess are included in the daily schedule.

Teacher Expectations

Teachers will work at the school building within the contracted hours of 7:30a.m.-3:15p.m, unless otherwise arranged with the principal. Throughout the school day, teachers will plan for instruction, create lesson plans, video and upload lessons, work with students, communicate with students and parents, and check and provide feedback on student work. Teachers will provide quality instruction across grade levels and be available to students and parents within contracted hours.

Communication

Each classroom teacher will send out a monthly newsletter outlining the plan for the month. Weekly lesson plans will be posted by Monday of each week in Google Classroom. Daily schedules and assignments will be posted in Google Classroom prior to 8:00 a.m. each day. Teachers will be available during office hours or by appointment.



Grading/Reporting

All turned in work will be graded and returned, weekly. This is to ensure individual feedback for students and parents on a regular basis. Student-progress reports will be sent out monthly. Official report cards will be sent out at the end of each trimester, three times per year.

Student Expectations

- Be dressed appropriately and ready to learn by the 8:00 a.m. school start time each day.
- Behave in a respectful manner; to be kind to their parents, their siblings, and their teachers.
- Follow all listed live Meet expectations (Norms).
- Put forth effort to do their best work and to complete all daily assignments and to turn in all required weekly work.
- Stay organized with materials at home.

Parent Responsibilities

- Model a positive attitude
- Help your child log in to 8:00 a.m. morning all school prayer and classroom meets
- Help your child be ready for the school day, awake-alert-dressed-fed and ready to learn
- Help your child find a quiet space (preferably at a table) conducive for learning
- Help your child adhere to the school day schedule, to the best of your ability
- Help your child eat snacks, etc. during scheduled break times
- Help your child keep materials clean and organized
- Reach out to teacher with questions, concerns, or for assistance for your family
- Drop off completed work/pick up next week's work between 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. every Friday
- Contact teacher if child is sick and cannot participate on any given day
- All absences must be excused and work must be made up upon return to school
