SJCS offers multiple academic programs including Religion, Bilingual Pre-k, Multi-lingual Spanish/English Program, Music, P.E., and S.T.R.E.A.M, and multiple before and after school enrichment opportunities such as Folkloric Dance, Strings, Robotics, Math is Cool, & Baking Club.

Middle School Expansion

St. Joseph Catholic School is expanding its curriculum to include middle school. Sixth grade was established in 2024-25, 7th grade will be added in 2025-26, and 8th grade will be added in 2026-27. The school is excited to add additional art and music opportunities to our curriculum over the next two years. This position could become a more full time position in the future.
